

Screening for Symptoms of COVID-19

Objective:

To provide guidance for administrators and staff or other related parties working on detecting COVID-19 symptoms on people in order to prevent them from entering the College.

Purpose:

To limit the exposure and contain COVID-19, the College encourage all employees, students and visitors to stay home for their and everyone else's safety in case any symptoms are observed.

Steps

As more information becomes available about COVID-19 every day, CUCA will continue to update and share information with its stakeholders.

As per (we need the source) people with COVID-19 have a wide range of reported symptoms which may appear between 2-14 days after exposure. Symptoms may include:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- · Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

On a daily basis, the CUCA shall conduct symptom screening for all its staff, students, and visitors. Symptom screening is intended to identify people who have possible indications of COVID-19. Those individuals are then kept from entering the College to reduce the risk of spreading of the virus. Screenings are conducted from assessing temperature or reflecting cold symptoms. Staff is mandated to get their COVID-19 tests on a regular basis.

All employees, students and visitors are allowed entry only from two entrances. At the entrance of the College, a security and/or a medical staff is stationed to observe the temperature through a thermal camera. Assigned staff inquires the COVID-19 result test and registers it in the system along with their Emirates ID. If temperature of 37.5 degree and above is detected, a medical staff is called to verify and concerned individual is sent



back as a precaution. He/she is asked to bring in an updated COVID-19 test the next time he/she visits the College.

In case symptoms are observed while at the College, a medical staff is called immediately to take the temperature and if symptoms are ascertained, the concerned party is sent home. If there is a wait for transportation or due to any other reason, the concerned individual is sent to the isolation room on the ground floor of the College. A PPE kit is a must to be worn by this individual and anyone who is within certain distance and/or escorting him/her. No exchange of PPE kits is allowed.
