

SUSTAINABLE TRANSPORTATION POLICY

Purpose:

City University Ajman has continuously improved the implementation of transportation programs to aid in reduction of air pollution, traffic congestion, GHG emissions and lessen the environmental impacts from commuting, fleet and travel.

Scope:

1. Create awareness among the students and staff and promote the overall health and wellbeing of the campus community by encouraging and facilitating cycling and walking.
2. Achieve cost savings and to support local economies: by reducing the use of petroleum-based fuels for transportation.
3. Support carpooling to travel to and from the university: carpooling will reduce the number of vehicles entering the campus.
4. Transportation services for students, staff.
5. In the unexpected times, there is no option to be flexible which is when Emergency Ride is facilitated to hospitals, homes, etc.
6. Encourage car-sharing in campus to minimize the number of cars entering the campus.
7. Provisions for electric car parking for students and faculty members that can be accessible.
8. Within the parking zone each area is mapped and provisioned for easy access and to manage traffic and to avoid excess fuel consumption for all user types as follows:
 - General parking
 - Taxi Rank
 - Authorized visitor parking
 - Student Drop-off/pick-up zone
 - Parking areas for people with determination in close proximity to campus buildings which are compliant with the required accessibility standards
 - Managers/HOD's reserved parking
9. Scheduling Major deliveries in non-peak periods to minimize impacts to campus operations and maximize safety of campus users. Contact shall be made with the relevant college contact person to determine the preferred time for deliveries and the specific location where the delivery is required to be made.
